



Our spring release is significant to us for a number of reasons. First, 2010 marks our 10th vintage. Second, this is the finest release of wines from our Estate since the 2001 vintage and perhaps our best wines ever. These wines deserve a place on your wine list or in your cellar. Also significant, we have made our prices more approachable to be in line with my personal belief that Blue Rock should be “an affordable luxury”.

2006 Blue Rock Estate Syrah

Our Syrah comes from a steep hillside and is now mature at 12 years old. It was planted with budwood that came from the famed Ch. De Beaucastel in the Rhone Valley. The 2006 is dark garnet in color and smells of blackberry, cassis, and white pepper. In the mouth it is beautifully mineral in quality with nice cassis and blackberry fruit. There are hints of white pepper which play a nice counterpoint to the wet stone minerality that underlies the wine, and faint, leathery tannins add complexity and texture. It is easy to drink and delicious now but will age and improve for 5 or more years.
