



Our spring release is significant to us for a number of reasons. First, 2010 marks our 10th vintage. Second, this is the finest release of wines from our Estate since the 2001 vintage and perhaps our best wines ever. These wines deserve a place on your wine list or in your cellar. Also significant, we have made our prices more approachable to be in line with my personal belief that Blue Rock should be “an affordable luxury”.

2007 Baby Blue Cabernet

Our first vintage, 2006, was wildly popular and sold out within a month of release. The 2007 is even better! Our philosophy for Baby Blue is to make a wine (primarily from the young vines) that has real character and at an everyday price. As a result, the fruit is all Estate, the oak all French, and the limited production is by hand. While it does not have the depth and layers of its sibling it is, simply put, the most serious, complex wine under \$30.00 that I know of.

The 2007 is medium garnet in the glass and the nose is of cassis and espresso. In the mouth the wine is high toned, with cassis, black cherry, and espresso notes. Light tannins creep around the edges of the mouth with a slightly leathery texture. The wine is approachable with sweet, soft tannins. It is delicious now and intended for consumption within 5 years.
